

ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO REGULATIONS  
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE

The attached one page of regulations, dealing with gaming activity, is adopted and certified to be a correct copy of the regulation changes that the Department of Revenue adopts under the authority of AS 43.05.080 and after compliance with the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), specifically including notice under AS 44.62.190 and 44.62.200 and opportunity for public comment under AS 44.62.210.

This action is not expected to require an increased appropriation.

In considering public comments, the Department of Revenue paid special attention to the cost to private persons of the regulatory action being taken.

The regulation changes adopted under this order take effect on the 30th day after they have been filed by the lieutenant governor, as provided in AS 44.62.180.

15 AAC 160 is amended by adding a new section to read:

**15 AAC 160.671. Dispensing raffle and lottery tickets by vending machine.** (a) To use a vending machine to sell raffle or lottery tickets, the permittee or operator must receive prior approval from the department.

(b) Before the department will approve the use of a vending machine under this section,

(1) the permittee or operator must certify, in writing, that the operation of the vending machine is compliant with the applicable requirements of AS 05.15 and this chapter;

(2) the permittee or operator must post a copy of the permit and a copy of the operator's license, if applicable, in a manner that is clearly visible to the gaming public;

(3) the name and permit number of the qualified organization that benefits from the proceeds of the vending machine must appear conspicuously on the vending machine or on a video screen display on the vending machine; and

(4) the name, telephone number, and address of the person responsible for servicing the vending machine must appear conspicuously on the vending machine or on a video screen display on the vending machine.

(c) In this section, "vending machine" means a machine, object, or instrument designed to sell and dispense a raffle or lottery ticket. (Eff. 5/25/2016, Register 218)
