**On Potential Changes to Oil and Gas Production Tax Regulations**

The Department of Revenue is holding a public workshop to discuss and receive comments and suggestions from interested members of the public concerning potential changes to regulations in Title 15 of the Alaska Administrative Code, to implement recent legislation relating to the oil and gas production tax, SCS SCHB 2001(FIN) am S. The principal subjects of potential regulations to be addressed at the workshop are (1) a draft of transportation costs in accordance with AS 43.55.150, and (2) a discussion of the Proposed Model to Compute the Cost of Capital Allowance for Pipeline Facilities under 15 AAC 55.195(j).
