BTU Equivalents for Oil & Gas

The Department of Revenue is holding a public workshop to discuss and receive comments and suggestions from interested members of the public concerning the statutory requirement to use a per barrel BTU equivalent for determining the production tax value of gas and the allocation of lease expenditures in accordance with AS 43.55.

During the workshop the department intends to receive comment from operators and producers and discuss the types of equipment currently in place for measuring gas composition and volumes, the frequency with which samples are taken, and applicable standards used by industry in sampling gas production.
