Who cannot play? Who can play?

WHO CANNOT PLAY BINGO:

- A person under the age of 19 may not play a bingo game (AS 05.15.180(f)).
- The caller of a bingo game may not play a game of bingo conducted by the permittee at the location where the caller is working (15 AAC 160.500(b)).
- Refer to the house rules for additional prohibitions.

HOUSE RULES:

- A permittee or operator may adopt house rules that prohibit an employee from playing a game of bingo (15 AAC 160.500(a)).
- The house rules should be posted in a conspicuous place where bingo is conducted. (15 AAC 160.560(d)).

WHO CAN PLAY BINGO:

- Generally anyone can play bingo with the exception of a person under the age of 19, a caller of a bingo game, and those prohibited by house rules.
- Keep in mind that bingo should be conducted with high standards of integrity, and permittees and licensees must avoid relationships that could support an inference of a conflict of interest or self-dealing. Please refer to 15 AAC 160.954 Conflicts of Interest, for more information.
