Hello from the Charitable Gaming Group!

The purpose of this newsletter is to provide permit and license holders the resources they need to manage their gaming account. As you know, all activity related to your gaming permit or license is conducted through your [Revenue Online](#) account.

ONLINE TICKET SALES

House Bill 76 was signed into law by Governor Dunleavy on 4/30/2021.

Section 9 of the bill authorizes the online sale of tickets, and the drawing of the winning ticket online. Tickets that may be sold online include raffle/lottery, dog mushers' contest, derby, and classics defined at AS 05.15.690.

The online sale of tickets is subject to the purchaser certifying that they are of legal purchasing age, and that they are not physically present in an area that has adopted a local option that prohibits charitable gaming.

HEADS UP: NEW VENDOR REGISTRATION FORM FOR 2022

when you are ready to renew your vendor registration for calendar year 2022, please be sure to use the newest version (Rev 5/21) which is posted at our website.

Changes to the form clarify how to deliver the game to your vendor in exchange for a check in the minimum amount of 70 percent of the ideal net, what to do if a game is lost or stolen, and record retention requirements.
