Hello from the Charitable Gaming Group!

The purpose of this newsletter is to provide permit and license holders the resources they need to manage their gaming account. As you know, all activity related to your gaming permit or license is conducted through your [Revenue Online](#) account.

AROUND THE CORNER...ALMOST TIME TO RENEW YOUR PERMIT FOR 2022

It never hurts to get a jump start on renewing your permit or license. This year, the application to renew will be available in your Revenue Online account beginning 11/2/2021. All current permits and licenses expire on 12/31/2021.

A REFRESHER ON PERMIT RENEWALS AND ACH PAYMENTS

When it comes time to renew your permit, log into Revenue Online and look for the Account ID associated with the Account Type Permit. The ID numbers are the color blue which indicates a hyperlink. Once you click on the hyperlink, select Renew Now for the period 31-Dec-2022, and follow the prompts.

As you proceed you will be asked to choose how you want to pay for the permit renewal fee. You can select either “I would like to make an online ACH debit payment now,” or “I have already submitted a license payment or will submit a license payment outside of the application.”

If you choose to make an ACH payment you will be prompted to enter your bank account type (checking or savings), your bank’s routing number, and your bank account number. You can also save this information as your default bank account, so you don’t have to retype it in future years.

Once you submit your application you will automatically receive a confirmation number. If you navigate Home (upper left-hand corner), and wait 15-30 seconds (I know, but be patient) you will see the amount of the permit fee due will populate, in red numbers, at My Balance. If you navigate to the 2022 Permit Account ID, you should now see, in green numbers, the Pending balance of the fee you submitted. Once the ACH payment settles (typically two business days), both the My Balance and Pending fields will return to zero.

NEW VENDOR REGISTRATION FORM FOR 2022

when you are ready to renew your vendor registration for calendar year 2022, please be sure to use the newest version when obtaining the bar/liquor store owner’s signature, (Rev 5/21), which is posted at our website.

Changes to the form clarify how to deliver the game to your vendor in exchange for a check in the minimum amount of 70 percent of the ideal net, what to do if a game is lost or stolen, and record retention requirements.
