The Department of Revenue is holding a public workshop to discuss and receive comments and suggestions from interested members of the public concerning potential changes to regulations in Title 15 of the Alaska Administrative Code, to implement legislation relating to the oil and gas production tax, ch. 1, SSSLA 2007.

The principal subjects of potential regulations to be addressed at the workshop are: (1) reimbursements for adjustments under AS 43.55.170, and (2) treatment of tax credits claimed under AS 43.55.023(a) or (b).
